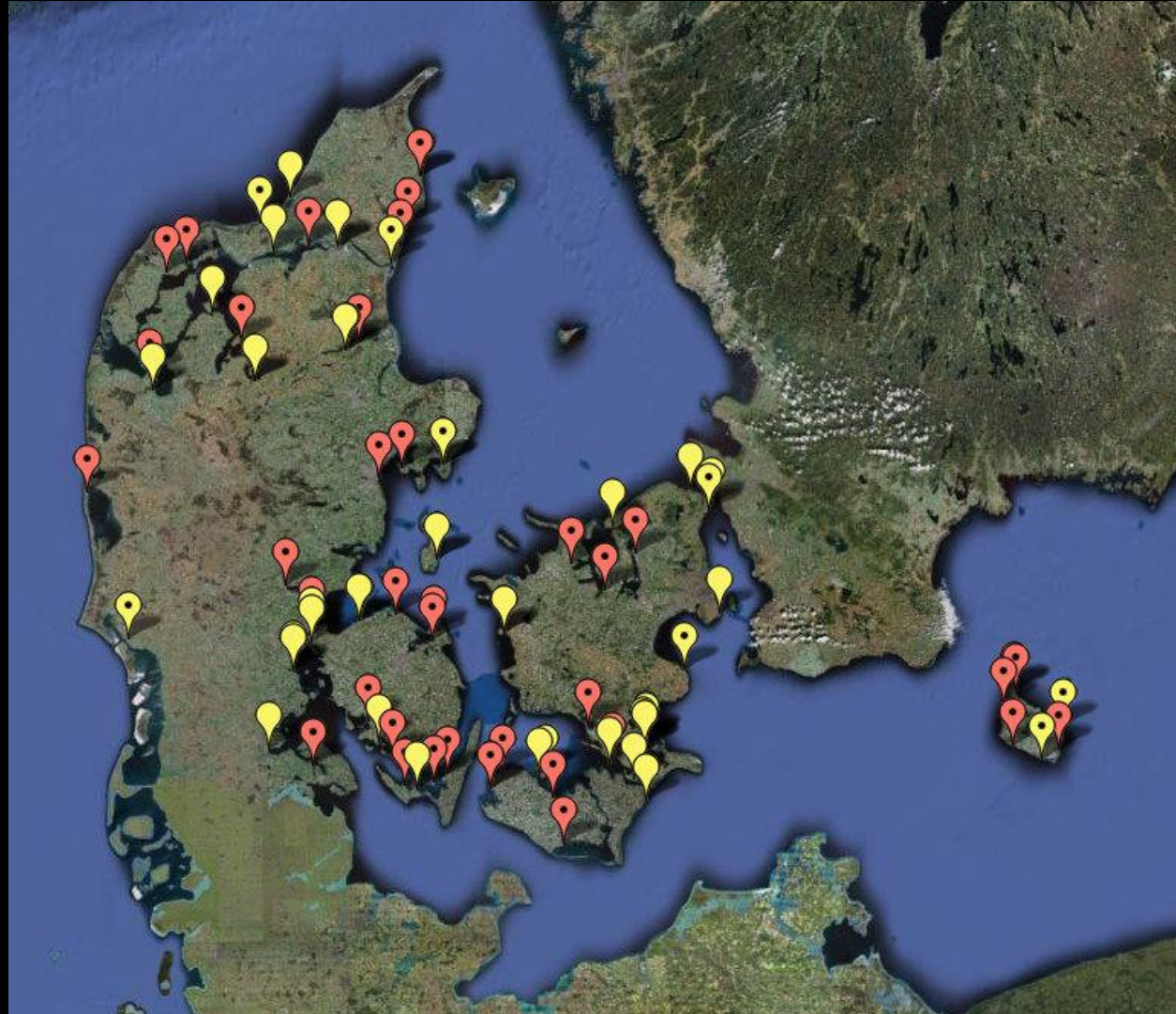
But, you're not alone...
